4. Have you ever been adjudicated mentally defective (which includes a determination by a court, board, commission, or other lawful authority that you are a danger to yourself or to others or are incompetent to manage your own affairs) OR have you ever been committed to a mental institution?

5. Have you ever been discharged from the armed forces under dishonorable conditions?

6. Are you subject to a court order restraining you from harassing, stalking, or threatening your child or an intimate partner or a child of such partner?

7. Have you ever been convicted on any court of a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence?

8. Have you ever renounced your United States citizenship?

9. Are you an alien illegally in the United States?

The USCCA Legal Defense Foundation was created to promote and protect the natural-born, self-defense rights of all responsibly armed Americans to protect themselves, their family, and their property by carrying concealed firearms.

All Applications will be reviewed by the USCCA Legal Defense Foundation on a case-by-case basis. The Foundation will examine whether the application and facts support the Mission Statement of the USCCA Legal Defense Foundation, examine whether the application meets the criteria set by the Foundation, and conduct its own investigation into your matter to determine whether a Grant will be made. A Grant will only be made after approval by the Foundation and if there are funds available for the Grant.

You will be advised by a representative from the USCCA Legal Defense Foundation the decision after a full examination has been made and the Foundation has reached a decision.

Application for a Grant does not guarantee that a Grant will be approved or made, the amount of the Grant if made, or otherwise. In the event a Grant is approved, you will be asked to sign a Grant Agreement.
